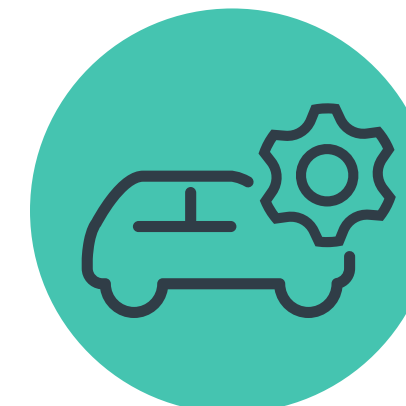

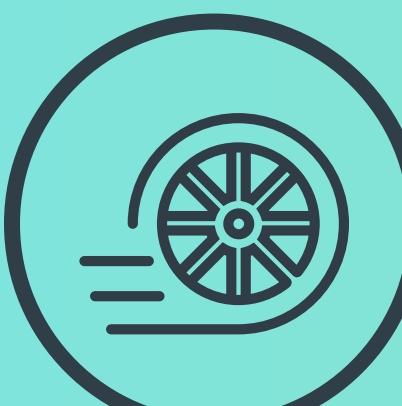
#### Maintenance costs
